Aloysius A. Spitulski, age 93, died Tuesday, December 4, 2012, at his residence at Manchester Presbyterian Lodge, in Erie, Pa. "Ollie", as he was endearingly called by everyone who knew and loved him, he was born in Toledo on September 19, 1919. He was the son of the late Henry and Helen (Andrzejewski) Spitulski. Ollie was the widower of Veronica, the love of his life and the dancer of his heart, who died in 1994.

Ollie was a Staff Sergeant in the US Army during WWII. He worked as a die caster for Chevrolet for 25 years, retiring in 1984. He was a Life Member of the American Legion Post 18 for 68 consecutive years and was a founding member of the Commodore Club of Toledo, an organization that was started by a group of young sports minded kids in 1933.

He remained devoted to his love of family, church, sports, dancing and music to the very end. His strength of body followed him throughout his 93 years, whether playing football in the Army, playing and coaching softball for the Commodore Club, dancing with his wife, Verna, at the Trianon Club and Polonia Hall, running in the Revco 10K Race in Cleveland, a home exercise program that included jogging, or jitterbugging at Alfredo's Dance Studio with friends.

Ollie's writing abilities were showcased in articles he wrote such as the Commodore Comments and Nativity HNS. As Commodore Club Historian, many articles can be found in the yearly scrapbooks he created and presented to the Commodore Club for over 60 years, which are kept in the Commodore archives.

As a dedicated member of the St. Patrick of Heatherdowns Rosary Group, Ollie demonstrated his deep reverence for his Catholic faith and devotion to the Blessed Mother. He would spread the Fatima message to all he met. A close second to his faith, Ollie was a die-hard follower of Notre Dame Football and all his family and friends enjoyed his boisterous cheers as the team completed their undefeated season this year.

Ollie leaves behind his children, Kenneth A.(Roberta) Spitulski of Erie, PA and Kathleen A.(Dennis) Brown of Euclid, OH; Grandchildren, Heather Biggie, Lauren (Justin) Orndorff, Mark Spitulski, and Cristin Brown, and great-grandchild Austin Biggie.
